WHITE OAKS MALL 2020 HOLIDAY UPDATE

MEMO FROM JEFF WILSON, GENERAL MANAGER

As we get closer to the start of our holiday season and the number of shoppers in the mall increase further, I wanted to address a few important items that may require your attention.

EXTENDED HOURS

Some stores have enquired about staying open past the Minimum Operating Hours. Starting Monday, November 23, all stores are permitted and encouraged to extend their hours and close as late as 9pm on Monday to Saturday. Extended hours will allow customers to access stores when it is most convenient to them as well as spreading out customer traffic over more hours to promote distancing between patrons.

To facilitate this, Mall Security and Cleaning services will operate as usual until 9pm each night (Monday-Saturday). For stores that set and commit to operating hours beyond the Minimum Operating hours, the Mall will promote those operating hours to help drive customer traffic in the extended hours. The extended hours are also a great time in which to offer "Invite Only", "Family & Friends", or Special Shopping Event promotions. If your store plans to run any events, please contact info@whiteoaksmall.ca and we will assist in promoting these events with you.

RESTRICTED CAPACITY

To ensure the safety of our employees and customers, White Oaks Mall has a plan in place to control access into the mall and limit the number of customers inside the building. This plan will be enacted if physical distancing within the common area becomes difficult to maintain.

Currently, the main source of congestion in the common areas is caused by queues for individual stores. As stores become busier, these queues will become longer. To offset this, I'm asking that all stores review their occupancy limits and ensure that they are set to the maximum number of people that can be admitted while maintaining distancing. As stores absorb more patrons inside the premises, the congestion within the common area of the mall decreases.
